2026 Rod Korhorn Memorial Scholarship Application

Application Instructions

The Byron Center Chamber of Commerce *Rod Korhorn Memorial Scholarship* will honor students graduating in 2026 who demonstrate character and citizenship in our community. All students who meet the eligibility requirements are highly encouraged to apply.

In 2026, scholarships of \$1,000 each will be awarded to graduating seniors selected from among those applicants who:

- 1. Live within the Byron Center Public Schools District boundaries
- 2. Graduate from an accredited high school or from a home-school program meeting State of Michigan requirements
- 3. Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5
- 4. Have been accepted to attend an accredited 2- or 4-year college or university or a trade school in Fall, 2026; and
- 5. Successfully complete the application process.

Application Procedure

To apply for a **2026 Rod Korhorn Memorial Scholarship**, you must submit the two-page Scholarship Application form (pages 3 and 4 of this document) including <u>all</u> the required information and signatures, and the Required Documents listed at the bottom of Page 2. You do not need to submit pages 1 and 2. For more information, see Page 2 of these instructions.

Submitting Your Application

To be considered, complete applications must <u>reach</u> the Chamber's office, its e-mail inbox, or its P.O. Box by 3:30 PM (EST) on Wednesday, February 4, 2026.

The Scholarship Award Process

All scholarship applications will be reviewed by the Chamber Scholarship Committee. From those submitted, finalists will be selected for a personal interview with the Scholarship Committee. Finalists will be notified of the Committee's decisions by April 2026. Payment of scholarship awards will be made directly to the institution at which you enroll.



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Specific Instructions for Required Materials

1. Application Form

- a. The Application Form (Page 3) must be submitted with the information printed legibly and directly on the form.
- b. Page 4 may be submitted using the form, with the information printed legibly, or may be submitted as a typed page (included with the Application) in either Microsoft Word or pdf format meeting the commonly accepted standards of professional business or educational written communication. It must include the information called for in the order listed.

2. Personal Essay:

- a. Please put your name at the top of the Essay.
- Describe how your involvement in community service, athletics, work, or other experience has made a significant impact on your life and future goals.
- c. Your Essay must be typed, limited to <u>one</u> page, provided in either Microsoft Word or pdf format, and should be structured like a formal school essay.

3. One Letter of Recommendation

- a. Letter must be from someone other than a family member.
- b. It must be provided in either Microsoft Word or .pdf format.
- c. Letter from someone employed at a school or business must be provided on the organization's letterhead. Those from individuals must bear the writer's name, return address, phone number, and the signature of the writer.
- 4. Any missing pieces of the application will deem the application incomplete and may not be considered.
